

STUDENT OVERNIGHT TRIP AGREEMENT

Students who participate in any aspect of this production take full personal responsibility for the following obligations and expectations:

1. Appropriate Behavior

- a. The student, at all times, respects every other person by using appropriate language, respecting another's physical and personal space, and by respecting the diversity of personal and cultural backgrounds of all involved.
- b. A student may not harass another person (publicly, personally, or via the internet).
- c. Students are subject to all rules and expectations outlined in the school handbook.
- d. NO student may enter another student's hotel room without the presence of a chaperone or coordinator
- e. Young men and young woman are never allowed in rooms of the opposite sex unless accompanied by a trip chaperone or coordinator.
- f. Students must treat all adult chaperones with respect.
- g. Students may not leave their hotel room after curfew unless to retrieve a chaperone or the coordinator.
- h. It is the student's responsibility to call home during the trip.
- i. Students are ALWAYS a representative of Their family, this school, and the Arts Program.

2. Academic Responsibilities

- a. The student must inform teachers before the event of his/her absence.
- b. The student is responsible to make up all tests, quizzes, homework, and assignments when agreed upon by the classroom teacher.

3. Respecting Facilities, Belongings and Environment

- a. The student is responsible for respecting all facilities, other's belongings, and the environment.
- b. The student is responsible for ensuring the appropriate security of all personal belongings.
- c. The student/family will be held financially responsible for any damage caused by that student during the trip.
- d. All hotel rooms must be respected and returned to original cleanliness.

4. Transportation Policy

- a. Students are responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of all modes of transportation.
- b. The student must be on time for all departures.

5. Luggage

- a. All luggage and personal belonging brought on the trip will be inspected by the trip coordinator and chaperones.

6. Smoking, Drinking and Drug Policy

- a. The student may not engage in any form of illegal act or action.
