Bishop Hendricken High School and CulinArt Group open the doors to an **all-new cafeteria experience** on August 30. Students, faculty and staff can look forward to:

- Expanded fresh-from-the-grill menu with burgers, sandwiches, tenders, and more available everyday
- Comfort-style hot entrees with side dishes, and satisfying kettle soups

- CulinArt's signature 'Eat Well' recipes, as well as vegetarian and vegan offerings

- Daily hot breakfast specials

We are also pleased to announce the introduction of a **new cashless dining program** at Bishop Hendricken High School, which is offered through our new point-of-sale register company ODIN Inc. **This convenient declining balance system aligns with student ID cards.** The program alleviates the burden of students having to carry cash, and also helps speed up the check-out process during the lunch rush. Students can check-out in a fraction of the time it takes to pay with cash by simply scanning their ID badge at the register. Purchases can be made as long as there is a sufficient balance in the account to cover the transaction. The total dollar amount of each transaction is automatically deducted, clearly displaying the new account balance. Students will be notified at checkout when their balance falls below \$15, at which time parents will also be notified via email. Parents may deposit funds into their child's account at any time, and may also opt to **set their account to conveniently auto-reload.** Parents or guardians can track when and how their money is being spent via the MyKidsSpending.com website. Detailed instructions on the enrollment process are enclosed. *Please note that cash and credit cards will also be accepted at the registers.*

Register for cashless dining by following the steps below:

1. Go to www.MyKidsSpending.com. Click on *Create Account*. Enter in the required fields (your email address, your first name, your last name, and your phone number). Next enter the required fields for the student (Bishop Hendricken High School, the Student I.D. Number, the student's first name, and the student's last name). Then click on *Register This Account*. You will have to repeat this step for each participating child in your family. Once finished, click the button labeled *Complete Registration*.
2. You will then receive an e-mail response with your **User I.D. and Password**. It is important that you keep this information as it will be your permanent User I.D. and Password to access your account.
3. Once you have your User I.D. and Password, log onto www.MyKidsSpending.com.
4. Enter your User I.D. and Password and follow the prompts to make deposits. Note that while you can deposit funds into your child's account at any time, the minimum deposit at any time is \$25.00 (per student). Visa and MasterCard are accepted, or you may pay by check, made payable to the CulinArt Group and mailed to "**Bishop Hendricken High School, 2615 Warwick Avenue, Warwick, RI 02889; Attention: CulinArt Dining Services**". Please also note that ODIN Inc. issues a 4% convenience fee for each transaction. If you use an electronic check in lieu of a credit card, there is a 1% convenience fee and \$0.75 transaction fee.
5. Each participating student is issued a Dining Service ID Number, to which their deposits are applied, and from which your child can make daily purchases in the school's cafeteria. The ID Number will align with the student's ID number which is on their ID card.
6. If you wish to **change your email and/or password** at any time, you may do so by selecting the link on the MyKidsSpending.com home page.
7. Participating families may review their account balances online at any time and parents will receive an email notification when the account has a low balance.
8. At the end of the year, balances will be rolled over to the next school year, but exiting students are required to use all funds on their account. CulinArt will not issue refunds to exiting students.
