UPDATE FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE

Dear Parents and Faculty,

Today, I write with the most exciting news we've received since the onset of the pandemic well over a year ago. I am pleased to announce that through a special partnership with the Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH) and the Rhode Island Disaster Medical Assistance Team (RIDMAT), Bishop Hendricken will be hosting a COVID-19 vaccine clinic for all eligible students, faculty, and staff on Monday, May 10, 2021 from 9am-11:30am.

This vaccination event is open to all Bishop Hendricken students, faculty, and staff members who are 16+ years of age. The clinic is **absolutely free** and dispensing the **Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine**. All those receiving their first dose at this clinic will be scheduled for a second dose on campus on Tuesday, June 1, 2021.

We've worked closely with the RIDOH and RIDMAT teams to strategically schedule these clinics to ensure all seniors have the opportunity to be fully vaccinated for prom on June 15, 2021 and graduation on June 18, 2021. If seniors take part in this vaccination effort on campus, we can ensure that if they were identified as a close contact, they would not be faced with a quarantine impacting either of these events.
